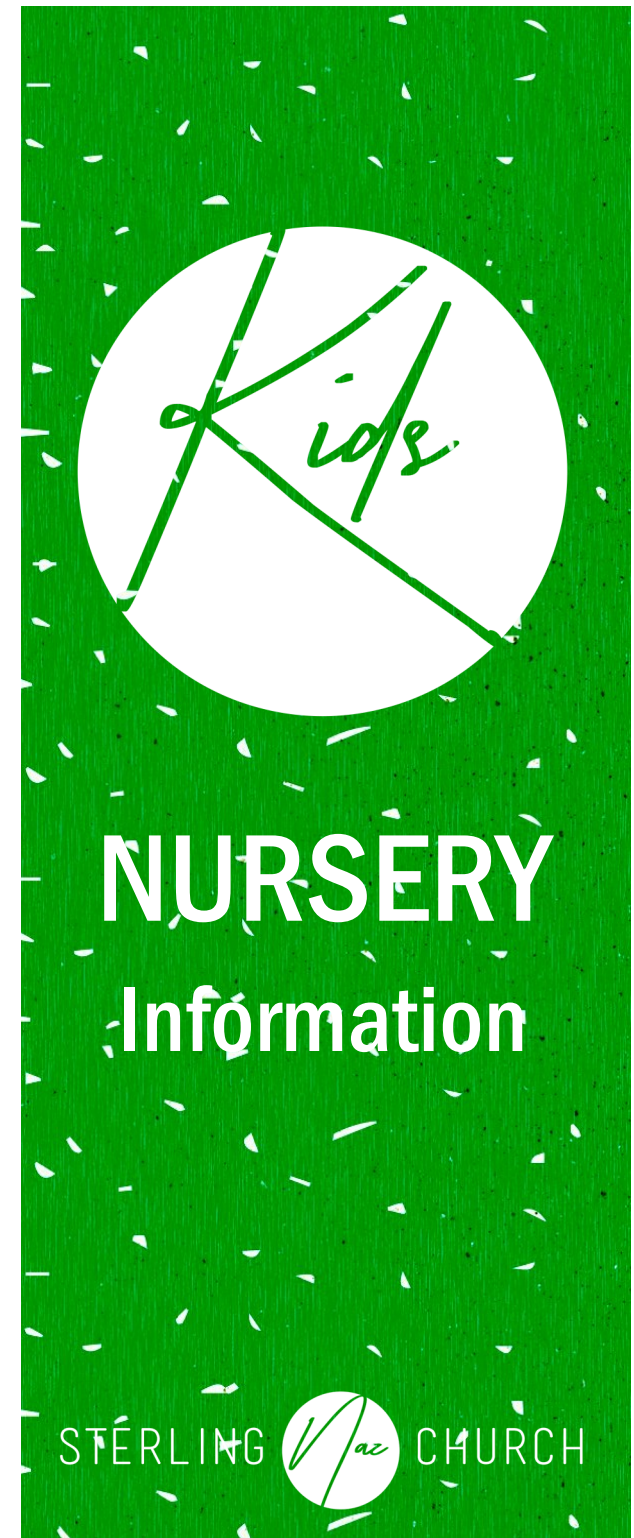

SCHEDULE

We offer nursery during most regular weekly services and programs:

- **Worship Service:** 10am to 11:05am
- **Life Groups:** 11:15am to 12pm
- **Wednesday Evening:** 6:30 to 7:30pm during the school year

AGE GROUPS

We offer 2 nurseries:

- **Infant & Toddler Nursery:** babies from birth to 2 years old
- **2s & 3s Classroom:** 2 and 3 year olds

Graduation:

We promote children to the next nursery, or PreK class on their birthday.

We offer a Mother's Room on the main floor where parents are able to nurse or change babies who do not attend the regular nursery. This room is for parents and babies/toddlers only and will not be staffed during services. Please feel free to use this room but do not leave children unattended.

WHAT TO BRING

In addition to a child in a clean, dry diaper, please bring a bag with the following items:

- 2 or 3 disposable diapers (no cloth, please)
- Wipes
- Diaper rash cream (optional)
- Comfort items: pacifiers with clip, blankets, etc.
- Change of clothes
- Bottle or sippy cup with formula or water

DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES

Upon arrival please check in at the Kids Welcome Center. We will ask you to do the following:

- Sign-in your child at the Children's Welcome Center
- Place a name tag to place on your child's back
- Update any new information with nursery workers

*During checkout, please line up outside the nursery door. For safety reasons **please do not enter the nursery.***

- Sign out your child on the clip board
- Hand nursery worker your child's claim ticket (only those listed on your child's registration form that have the corresponding ticket will be allowed to pick you your child. If ticket is lost a photo ID will be asked to be presented)
- Make sure you have your child's belongings

SICKNESS POLICY

For the safety of others, we will not admit a child with the following symptoms:

- Runny Nose
- Fever
- Rash
- Persistent Cough
- Diarrhea
- Yellow eye discharge
- *If your child has symptoms unrelated to contagious illness, like asthma or allergies, please let volunteers know*

SAFETY MEASURES

- We run background checks and train all volunteers
- All children are required to wear a name badge and parents must have corresponding ticket to pick up children
- We have locking doors to keep children safe during services
- We disinfect toys, surfaces and require hand washing/sanitizing
- We check photo IDs when a person's authority to pick up a child is in question
- We plug outlets and use childproof locks on cabinets and doors
- We stock nurseries with first aid kits and document injuries
- We follow an emergency evacuation plan in the event of a fire or tornado
